

How Do I Update My Maine Tax Tables?

Where do I find the tax tables?

For ME tax tables, you will need the current "[Withholding Tables for Individual Income Tax](#)" publication from the [ME Department of Revenue](#).

Which tables do I use?

Use the annual percentage formula tables method of withholding. Figure 1 shows an example.

Note that the figures shown in this document are for demonstration purposes only, and may not be current. Please consult the current publication for the most up-to-date information. Though the figures change periodically, the method of calculation should remain the same. If the calculation method has changed for this state please notify the [webmaster](#).

If the annualized income is:		The annualized withholding is:
Less than \$8,650		0.0%
\$8,650 but less than \$24,350		6.5% of excess over \$8,650
\$24,350 or more		\$1,021 plus 7.95% of excess over \$24,350
	For Married Taxpayers	
If the annualized income is:		The annualized withholding is:
Less than \$20,200		0.0%
\$20,200 but less than \$51,600		6.50% of excess over \$20,200
\$51,600 or more		\$2,041 plus 7.95% of excess over \$51,600

How to setup/update the tables in PowerChurch Plus

To setup/update PowerChurch Plus with the state tax tables shown in Figure 1 above, select the **Accounting** menu, **Payroll, Setup**, then **Maintain Tax Tables**. A separate table will need to be created for the single and married table rates.

Click Add to enter a new table, or use the Find/Locate buttons to select an existing ME tax table to update. When adding a new table, you will be prompted for the type of tax table you're adding. Select **State: Maine**. For each table, enter the following information:

- **Description:** Enter a unique name to identify the tax table (for example, "ME State Tax - Married").
- **Tax type:** The type of tax in which this table applies. In this instance, select State Tax.
- **Withholding allowance:** Enter the amount for one withholding allowance. Figure 2 shows an example from the Withholding Tables publication.

Step 2 Multiply the number of withholding allowances the employee claims by \$4,000. Subtract the result from the annualized wage amount calculated in step 1 to compute the annualized income.

Figure 2 - 2015 Withholding Allowance

- **Round tax to nearest whole dollar:** Check this box to round the calculated tax amount to the nearest whole dollar.
- **Annual Rate Table:** Click the Annual Rate Table tab. From the annual percentage tables (Figure 1), for each bracket enter the maximum income amount to which the rate applies and the tax rate.
